BSNL waives USSD charges

New Delhi, November 28

BSNL has decided to waive charges on short code messages used for availing banking services on feature phones, till January 31. "To give impetus to the demonetisation drive by the Centre and facilitate masses to do cashless financial transactions even with feature phones, BSNL has decided to waive the tariff of National Unified USSD platform till January 31, 2017," the telecom PSU said in a statement. BSNL had signed an agreement with National Payment Corporation of India (NPCI) for provision of USSD-based Mobile Banking service, it said.
