ASI inks MoU with Railtel, BSNL for wi-fi services

Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has signed an MoU with state-run Railtel and BSNL for providing wi-fi facilities at its various monuments and sites. The service will be free for the first half-an-hour and thereafter chargeable on usage basis.

Currently, ASI has 116-ticketed monuments and sites and the services would be available wherever "technically feasible," culture minister Mahesh Sharma said in a written reply in Lok Sabha.
